Notice is hereby given that a Charter amendment has been proposed for adoption, and been considered at a first reading thereof, by the City of Temple. This proposed Charter amendment eliminates the requirement that ordinances be read at two regular meetings of the City prior to official adoption thereof; and other proposed revisions, regarding the approval of City ordinances.

Copies of this proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Temple are on file in the office of the Clerk of the City of Temple and in the office of the Clerk of the Superior Court of Carroll County, Georgia, for the purpose of examination and inspection by the public.

A public hearing concerning the proposed Charter amendment will be conducted at 6:30 p.m. at the April 2, 2018 regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Temple to be called and held at City Hall. At this public hearing, comments, either orally or in writing, pursuant to the rules and procedure of the Council, will be accepted for inclusion in the record and consideration by the City Council prior to the final review for adoption of this proposed Charter amendment.
