

PUBLIC HEARINGS ON UPDATE OF COMPREHENSIVE PLAN

CITY OF TEMPLE

6:30 p.m. -- Temple Senior Center (280 Rome Street)

The City of Temple will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. Monday, March 19, 2018, at the City of Temple Senior Center concerning a full update of its local Comprehensive Plan. This update is required by the State of Georgia and will be prepared in accordance with rules promulgated by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA). (The City of Temple did its most recent update in 2014.)

The Mayor and City Council have appointed a Steering Committee to guide development of this update. A majority of this Steering Committee is composed of local private citizens, and the committee also includes two City Council members, two City staff members, and a member of the City of Temple Planning Commission. (The Steering Committee will have its first meeting at 5:45 p.m. on March 19 at the Senior Center, which will be immediately prior to this announced public hearing.)

The purpose of the public hearing will be to brief the community on the process to be used to update the local Comprehensive Plan, to explain the opportunities for public participation in development of the plan update over the next few months, and to obtain input on the proposed planning process. Those interested in learning about and participating in the plan update should attend this meeting.

The Three Rivers Regional Development Commission (RDC) will provide staff assistance to the Steering Committee as this plan is developed for submission to the Georgia DCA this fall.
