

PUBLIC HEARINGS ON WATER AND SEWER

The City of Temple will hold two public hearings concerning water and sewer daily operations, the City's utility billing system, the cost increases from the Carroll County Water Authority on water sold to the City of Temple for its residents and businesses, and the necessity of raising water and sewer rates.

Each public hearing will have a different agenda; namely as stated below...

Thursday, March 15, public hearing agenda to consist of presentation and discussion of the overall water and sewer operation in Temple, possible changes in some of those operations and the cost of those operations, and questions and comments from citizens concerning problems, issues, and possible solutions. (Specific possible changes in current water and sewer rates will not be presented or discussed during this public hearing.)

Thursday, March 29, public hearing agenda to include feedback to the public from the first public hearing and then followup discussion, presentation and discussion of specific changes in water and sewer rates to be considered and possibly acted on by the City Council during its regular monthly meeting at City Hall on Monday, April 2.
