

**CITY OF TEMPLE MINUTES  
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE TEMPLE CITY COUNCIL  
THURSDAY, JUNE 19, 2008 – 6:30 PM  
TEMPLE CITY HALL**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Ford called the Special Called meeting of the Temple City Council to order at 6:30 pm with the following members present constituting a quorum: Councilmember Richard Bracknell, Councilmember Larry Estvanko, Councilmember Larry Mann, Councilmember Hiley Miller, and Councilmember William Simmons.

**CITIZENS COMMENTS:** Mayor Ford announced that the current city attorney had resigned; so anyone wishing to speak on item #4 will only be allowed to discuss the appointment of a new city attorney and not the pending litigation involving the former city attorney.

Mayor Ford opened the floor for citizen's comments. There being none, the floor was closed.

**NEW BUSINESS:**

1. **Solid Waste Management Plan:** After discussion, Simmons motioned to adopt the Solid Waste Management Plan second by Mann unanimous by Council.
2. **Temple Residential and Commercial Waste (Trash) Removal Contract:**

Pope, City Clerk presented one item under consideration of bids:

- A. **Waste Removal Contract for the City of Temple:** The City of Temple received two sealed bids.
  - a. **MST Services:** Residential: \$10.95 monthly per can, 2 yard dumpster: \$45.00, 4 yard dumpster: \$75.00, 6 yard dumpster: \$95.00, and 8 yard dumpster: \$115.00.
  - b. **Waste Industries:** Residential: \$9.95 monthly per can, 2 yard dumpster: 25.72, 4 yard dumpster: \$51.44, 6 yard dumpster: \$77.16, and 8 yard dumpster: \$102.88.

After discussion, Estvanko motioned to approve the low bidder ( Waste Industries) second by Bracknell unanimous by Council.

3. **Addendum to Waste Removal Contract:** Russell, Public Works Director presented a proposal to the Council to increase the cost of residential pick up from \$9.50 to \$11.00 per can and also an increase of 3% per commercial dumpster. Simmons motioned to approve the increase but the motion was denied due to lack of a second. Mann motioned for an increase from \$9.50 to \$10.50 per can for residential service and also a 3% increase per commercial dumpsters second by Bracknell unanimous by Council.

**4. Appointment of City Attorney:**

Mayor Ford advised we had been in contact with five attorneys' during the week. Two had declined to submit a proposal and we interviewed three the last two days. Mayor Ford explained based on the interviews; we are recommending Mrs. Cynthia Matthews Daley for the position of City Attorney. After discussion; Simmons motioned to accept the recommendation of the mayor and appoint Mrs. Daley as the new city attorney second by Mann unanimous by Council.

**MAYOR AND COUNCIL CLOSING COMMENTS:** Estvanko motioned to amend the SPLOST wish list in order to add a skate park (Bid \$284,051.00) second by Bracknell. The motion carries on a vote of 4-1 with Mann voting against.

**ADJOURNMENT:**

A motion for adjournment was made by Mann at 7:00 pm second by Bracknell unanimous by Council.
