MONDAY, APRIL 12, 2010 – 6:30 PM  
TEMPLE CITY HALL**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Ford called the meeting of the Temple City Council to order at 6:30 p.m. with the following members present constituting a quorum: Councilmember Richard Bracknell, Councilmember William Simmons, Councilmember Hiley Miller; Councilmember Jay Mann and Councilmember Terron Bivins.

**INVOCATION:** The invocation was given by Councilmember Jay Mann

**CITIZENS COMMENTS:**

Mayor Ford opened the floor for citizen’s comments and there were none.

**COMMITTEE MEETING REPORTS:**

**Public Safety:** No Committee Report

**CONSENT AGENDA:**

Councilmember Richard Bracknell motioned to approve the consent agenda; seconded by Councilmember Jay Mann. Motion carried 5-0

**NEW BUSINESS:**

- 1.) Integra Water:** Councilmember Hiley Miller motioned to forgo the public hearing and any further discussion with Integra Water; seconded by Councilmember Terron Bivins. Motion carried 5-0

**2.) Waive Water/Sewer Deposit and Business Occupational Tax Fees:** Councilmember Richard Bracknell motioned to waive the water/sewer deposit along with the business occupational tax fees for TACUM; seconded by Councilmember Jay Mann. Motion carried 5-0

**3.) Waive Senior Center Rental Fees:** Councilmember William Simmons motioned to waive the senior center rental fees for the osteoporosis screening through TACUM; seconded by Councilmember Richard Bracknell. Motion carried 5-0

**4.) Waive Yard Sale Permit Fees:** Councilmember Terron Bivins motioned to waive the yard sale permit fees for the Hwy 78 yard sale on April 24, 2010; seconded by Councilmember Richard Bracknell . Motion carried 5-0

**5.) Addition to Employee Handbook:** Councilmember Jay Mann motioned to give the city administrator the approval to get a 7 year department of motor vehicle report on new employees at their expense during the application process; seconded by Councilmember Terron Bivins. Motion carried 5-0

**6.) Resolution:** Councilmember Richard Bracknell motioned approve the resolution to ban smoking inside all city owned building and from at least 25 feet away from an entrance or exit to a city owned building, as well as make spelling corrections; seconded by Councilmember William Simmons. Motion carried 5-0

**7.) Resolution for New Hires:** Councilmember Richard Bracknell motioned to approve the resolution effective April 15, 2010 that all new hired employees will be responsible for paying 100% of dependent coverage on medical and dental insurance provided by the city, as well as make spelling corrections; seconded by Councilmember Hiley Miller. Motion carried 4-1  
Councilmember Terron Bivins opposing

**8.) Contract to Release from Ownership and Maintenance:** Councilmember Hiley Miller motioned to release from ownership and maintenance lots 1-11 & lot 24 on Moore's Circle/Rainey Road David Harrison Mobile Home Park so they can install one master meter instead of individual meters as the other half of the mobile home park has. This makes David Harrison responsible for the maintenance and billing of the master meter; seconded by Councilmember Jay Mann. Motion carried 5-0
