

**CITY OF TEMPLE MINUTES
SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE TEMPLE CITY COUNCIL
MONDAY, AUGUST 30, 2010 – IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWIN COMMITTEE MEETING
TEMPLE CITY HALL**

CALL TO ORDER:

Mayor Ford called the Special Called Meeting of Temple City Council to order at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present constituting a quorum: Councilmember Richard Bracknell, Councilmember William Simmons, Councilmember Hiley Miller, Council Member Jay Mann and Councilmember Terron Bivins

INVOCATION:

Council Member Jay Mann gave the invocation for the meeting

CITIZENS COMMENTS: Mayor Ford opened up the floor for citizens comments. There were none so the floor was closed.

OLD BUSINESS:

1.) Awarding of Bid: Sidewalk Improvements and GATEway Landscape Enhancement Project
After sending all of the bids back to committee for comparisons Council Member Hiley Miller motioned to approve the bid from Perfect Turf Landscaping who came in with the lowest bid of \$105,927.91; seconded by Council Member Jay Mann. Motion carried 5-0. The total paid from the GATEway Landscape grant will be \$33,350.20.

NEW BUSINESS:

1.) Golf Cart Ordinance: 1st read

City Attorney Cynthia Daley read the ordinance for the 1st read; the 2nd read will be at the regular scheduled council meeting on Monday, September 13, 2010 @ 6PM.

Council Member Richard Bracknell motioned to amend the agenda to add the following agenda item; seconded by Council Member Williams Simmons. Motion carried 5-0

2.) Resolution to name the Recreation Pavilion, the Powell-Luke Pavilion: After discussion Council Member Richard Bracknell motioned to approve the resolution to name the pavilion The Powell-Luke Pavilion with the correction of spelling issues in the resolution; seconded by Council Member Terron Bivins. Motion Carried 5-0

EXECUTIVE SESSION: Councilmember Richard Bracknell motioned to adjourn at 6:07 pm in order to go into executive session for the purpose of discussing personnel, real estate and legal; seconded by Councilmember William Simmons. The motion carries 5-0.
