

**CITY OF TEMPLE MINUTES  
TEMPLE CITY COUNCIL  
MONDAY, JUNE 7, 2010 – 6:30 PM  
TEMPLE CITY HALL**

**CALL TO ORDER:**

Mayor Ford called the meeting of the Temple City Council to order at 6:30 p.m. with the following members present constituting a quorum: Councilmember Richard Bracknell, Councilmember William Simmons, Councilmember Hiley Miller; Councilmember Jay Mann and Councilmember Terron Bivins.

**INVOCATION:** The invocation was given by Councilmember Richard Bracknell

**CITIZENS COMMENTS:**

Mayor Ford opened the floor for citizen's comments and there being none the floor was closed.

**COMMITTEE MEETING REPORTS:**

There were no committee reports this month due to committee meeting being cancelled.

**CONSENT AGENDA:**

Councilmember William Simmons motioned to approve the consent agenda; seconded by Councilmember Richard Bracknell. Motion carried 5-0

**OLD BUSINESS:**

**1.) Ordinance to establish Job Descriptions, Salary Scales and Performance Evaluations:** 2<sup>nd</sup> Read: After the second read Council Member Richard Bracknell motioned to establish the ordinance as read; seconded by Council Member Jay Mann. Motioned carried 5-0

**NEW BUSINESS:**

**1.) Presentation of Certificate to Major Temple Garden Club:** Mayor Rick Ford the Major Temple Garden Club a proclamation for all of the hard work, time and effort they have put into making the City of Temple beautiful.

**2.) Renewal of Liability Insurance for City of Temple:** Council Member Jay Mann motioned to approve the liability insurance with Travelers insurance and to increase the policy \$1 million dollars for a savings of over \$20,000; seconded by Council Member Bracknell. Motion carried 5-0

**3.) Opening of Sealed bids for Road Improvement Projects:** Councilmember Richard Bracknell motioned to send the open bids back to the committee for further review; seconded by Councilmember Hiley Miller. Motion carried 5-0. The open bids were as followed:

**7.) Change date of Council Meeting for July 2010:** Councilmember Jay Mann motioned to leave the Committee Meeting the same for June 28, 2010 at 5pm with the exception of having it at the gym and the regular council meeting will be changed to Thursday, July 8, 2010 at 6:30pm; seconded by Councilmember Terron Bivins. Motion carried 5-0
