1. To Discuss End of Year Pay

Department Head: Dewayne Eberhart presented pictures of all three trees in questions, including three different estimates.

- 1. Reeves Tree Service: (three Trees)\$4,475.00
- 2. AB Tree Service: (Two Trees) \$3,900.00
- 3. GSA Tree Service: (Two Trees) \$4,850.00

After some discussion there was a motion to see if there was enough in the 2015 budget to remove the trees using Reeves Tree Service to cut all three trees by Council Member Hiley Miller 2nd by Council Member Bracknell. Vote 5-0

Council Member Miller excused herself.

- 3. Mayor Lester Harmon: Mr. Larry Mann said a tree on Highway 113 at Mr. Wright's house was over the road and falling and he would be happy to trim the tree if the council would agree and have the community service crew block the road and clean it up he would do it for free. A question of liability for the city was asked and Mayor Harmon said that we should contact the City Attorney to see about liability. A motion to ask attorney and see if it was ok if so we would accept Mr. Larry Mann's offer to cut the tree by Council Member Simmons Seconded by Council Member Bracknell vote 4-0


IV. **Department Heads:**
