City Administrator Bill Osborne gave a brief report on the budget; he stated on Monday night they presented a balanced general fund budget. He stated at the prior meeting Councilmember Walden pointed out that under the "property tax bill" line, which showed \$32,500, we did not need as much as it showed. The figure has been changed from \$32,500 to \$26,500 and the \$6,000 was moved to the contingency line under administration. After a brief discussion, they Mayor asked if the Council or public had any more questions or comments. There was no comment from the public. Mayor Harmon closed that portion of the public hearing.
