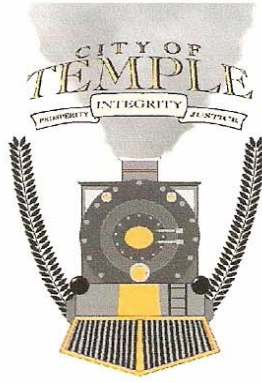

THE CITY OF TEMPLE WATER AUTHORITY **RELAXED WATER RESTRICTIONS**

Due to ongoing water conservation efforts by Carroll County Water Authority customers and relatively stable drought conditions in the West Georgia area, water use restrictions for Carroll County will be relaxed. CCWA filed a petition with the Georgia Environmental Protection Division for Level IVc drought response modifications, which are more generous than the standard Level IV restrictions that were imposed by the State of Georgia earlier this year. The Georgia EPD reviewed CCWA's petition and granted approval of the Level IVc relaxed water restrictions on June 9, 2008. The new water use provisions become effective on June 10, 2008.

The new water use restrictions for City of Temple customers are as follows:

- Customers may use water outdoors between 12:00 midnight and 10:00 a.m. on designated days based on an odd or even address system. Outdoor water use includes watering new and existing landscaping, pressure washing houses/fences/decks, washing cars, and filling ornamental fountains, just to name a few.
- Customers with odd addresses may use water on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays.
- Customers with even addresses may use water on Saturdays, Mondays and Wednesdays.
- Outdoor water use is not allowed on Fridays.
- Filling of swimming pools is allowed without restrictions on day or time.

Georgia EPD restricts accessing fire hydrants for activities other than maintenance of the water system, protection of the public health, or fire protection. EPD also restricts the washing of hard surfaces, such as washing sidewalks, driveways, and parking lots.

The City of Temple will continue to monitor water supplies and drought conditions and may implement more stringent water use restrictions as necessary.
