## MINUTES CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL CALLED MEETING November 28, 2022 Temple Senior Center 5:30PM

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Mayor Michael Johnson at 5:30PM.

Council Members Present: Richard Bracknell, Hiley Miller, Casey Russom, Tom Wallace, Howard Walden

Invocation and Pledge of Allegiance: Led by Mayor Michael Johnson

## Approve published agenda of this date's Special Called Meeting as presented:

Mayor Johnson explained that he would like to move the Executive Session to the beginning of the agenda. There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to approve the agenda with the change being made to move the Executive Session to the beginning, second by Council Member Walden, Vote 5-0.

There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to go into Executive Session for legal reasons, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 5-0.

There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to come out of Executive Session and go back into regular session, second by Council Member Russom. Vote 5-0.

1. <u>Discussion, with consideration to select the City of Temple's consulting engineering firm Turnipseed Engineers to oversee completion of the City Hall Expansion project.</u>

There was a motion by Council Member Bracknell to sign a contract with Turnipseed to oversee completion of the City Hall expansion project, not to exceed 20,000, subject to review of legal, second by Council Member Walden. Vote 5-0.

2. Report on the City of Temple's current contract with CSRA Probation Services, Inc., including a brief review of the company's probation services and programs for the Temple Municipal Court and the need to renew the current agreement which expires on November 30, 2022; discussion

Chief Creig Lee explained that everything is still the same: the same rules, same company, same employees. He believes that the fee went up by \$5.00. City Administrator Bill Osborne explained that the contract is a continuation of the contract that we currently have. The new contract would expire on December 31<sup>st</sup> of next year. He stated the company has done a good job for us and we need to renew the contract for continuity.

3. Consider approving a new contract with CSRA Probation Services, Inc., for the provision of probation services and programs to the Temple Municipal Court as set forth in the proposed new contract that would be effective as of Thursday, December 1, 2022, for a period ending on December 31, 2023 and with an automatic annual renewal through December 31, 2027, unless either party terminates said contract in accordance with its cancellation provisions

There was a motion by Council Member Walden to approve and sign a new contract with CSRA Probation Services, Inc., second by Council Member Wallace. Vote 5-0.
